I would like to suggest a list of authors and titles that would be appropriate for beginning second grade. **It is expected that your child choose at least 3 books from the suggested list below. Please record each book your child reads this summer to be submitted during the first week of school.**

Some helpful hints:

Each child's reading level develops at a different rate; therefore, some titles may seem too easy or too difficult for your child. If your child picks a book you think may be too hard, have him/her read a full page aloud to you. If there are five or more mistakes while reading, the book is probably too difficult. If there are five errors or less, the book should be appropriate.

Please encourage your child to read as much as possible this summer to keep skills sharp and to help develop a love of reading for pleasure.

The library is a great place to visit to get started on your summer reading adventure! There are books available for check out to take home and they have free apps to download books to go with you anywhere your summer may take you. All you need is a library card to enjoy this free resource!
